

Maintenance Mechanic

Position Overview:

Repairs and maintains all rides and mechanical equipment in the park by utilizing knowledge and experience of various mechanical systems such as engines, motors, hydraulics, conveyors, electrical equipment, welds and welding. Ensures that all rides meet local, state, and federal safety requirements through daily inspection and supports the park daily operation.

Job Requirements:

- Work with architects, engineers, contractors and department personnel to achieve on time and on budget capital projects that increase the value of the park to our guests
- Study manuals to gain a better understanding of the working parts of rides and other equipment.
- Inspect rides daily by observing equipment in operation.
- Quickly locate the root cause of problems by looking for visual and audio clues.
- Dismantle devices to gain access, remove, and repair/replace defective parts then reassemble and test to assure that all defects are fixed.
- Apply preventive maintenance to rides and equipment such as cleaning, lubricating, and tightening parts.
- Make timely decisions and supports/ explains reasoning for decisions. Include appropriate people in the decision making process.
- Complete daily maintenance logs and review with the Maintenance Supervisor and formulate timelines for the completion of projects.
- Observe safety and security procedures; Report potentially unsafe conditions; and use tools and materials properly.
- Maintain facility in compliance with OSHA, NJDCA, and all other pertinent and applicable regulatory guidelines.
- Keep maintenance shop neat, clean, and well organized.
- Other duties as assigned that contribute to the overall operation of the park.

Skills and Abilities:

- Problem Solving - Identify and resolve problems in a timely manner; Gather and analyze information efficiently; and develop alternative solutions when needed.
- Technical Skills - Pursue training and development opportunities; strive to build knowledge and skills by utilizing various resources; and shares expertise with others.
- Communication - Articulate ideas and concepts to the rest of the team; Complete all supporting documentation in a clear and concise fashion; and able to read and interpret information quickly.
- Planning/ Organizing - Prioritize and plan weekly and daily activities; File appropriate documentation and able to furnish information on request; Fill downtime with appropriate task; and work in an efficient manner.
- Quality Control - Demonstrate accuracy and thoroughness in work; Look for ways to improve and promote quality; and able to monitor own work for quality assurance.
- Dependability - Follows instructions and responds to management direction; takes responsibility for own actions; complete task on time or notifies supervisor with an alternate plan and timeline; consistently at work and on time for scheduled shift; and Ensure responsibilities are covered when absent.

Physical Demands: The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Must be able to work outside in the park at various times throughout the year.
- Requires manual and bi-manual dexterity, fine and gross motor skills, eye/hand coordination, near vision, hearing and speech.
- This position is very active and requires standing, kneeling, bending, walking, reaching above shoulder, pushing and pulling.
- Requires occasional lifts and carries up to 50 to 70 pounds.
- Requires occasional carries up to 100 pounds with the assistance of a two-wheel hand truck.

Vision requirements: The vision requirements described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- You will be required to use close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.

Work environment: You will be required to work in various weather conditions all year long. Working weekends and holidays is required. Noise level of working conditions may be loud at times.
